30TH ANNIVERSARY**

**WHEREAS**, IN 1985, THE VENTURA COUNTY PROFESSIONAL PEACE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION (VCPPOA) WAS FORMED TO REPRESENT THE EMPLOYMENT INTERESTS OF THE COUNTY'S DEPUTY PROBATION OFFICERS, CORRECTIONS SERVICES OFFICERS, HARBOR AND AIRPORT PATROL OFFICERS, AND PARK RANGERS. IN 1996, THE VCPPOA WAS INCORPORATED AS A 501(c) (5) ORGANIZATION; AND

**WHEREAS**, IN 2015, THE VCPPOA CELEBRATE THEIR 30<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF PROVIDING QUALITY SERVICE AND REPRESENTATION; AND

**WHEREAS**, THE VCPPOA'S MISSION IS TO PROVIDE THE HIGHEST QUALITY AND MOST EFFECTIVE REPRESENTATION FOR ITS MEMBERS, AND TO ENSURE THAT THEIR INTERESTS ARE PROTECTED IN LABOR AND LEGAL MATTERS, ECONOMIC ISSUES, INSURANCE, AND OFFICER SAFETY; AND

**WHEREAS**, THE VCPPOA BOARD OF DIRECTORS ARE LEADERS AND ACTIVE PARTICIPANTS IN PEACE OFFICER LABOR ISSUES ON A STATE AND LOCAL LEVEL, AND PROVIDE A CREDIBLE AND EFFECTIVE VOICE IN THE AREAS OF BOTH LEGISLATION AND POLITICS; AND

**WHEREAS**, VCPPOA MEMBERS ARE DEDICATED TO PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL, CRITICAL PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES TO THE CITIZENS AND BUSINESSES OF VENTURA COUNTY; AND


**WHEREAS**, THE VCPPOA CREATED ITS 501(c) (3) CHARITABLE FOUNDATION IN 2009, AND ITS MEMBERS TAKE PRIDE IN GIVING BACK TO OUR COMMUNITY THROUGH VOLUNTARY SERVICE AND FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS. WITHIN THE FOUNDATION, A FALLEN OFFICERS FUND IS AVAILABLE TO SUPPORT AND ASSIST THE FAMILIES OF FALLEN PEACE OFFICERS, WHETHER DECEASED OR SERIOUSLY ILL.


